DeLuca's fiscally and socially responsible budget puts seniors first. He passed a balanced budget that pays off debt and saves for the future to put the state on more solid fiscal footing, while also making critical investments in health care, in-home care for seniors, Meals on Wheels, and other essential services.

Deluca is helping our most vulnerable residents maintain healthy, dignified, and independent lives. He voted to ensure seniors receiving Meals on Wheels have access to information on diabetes, elder abuse, elder neglect, financial exploitation, Social Security benefits, and Medicare.

DeLuca is changing the way state government operates. He delivered major ethics and lobbying reforms, including term limits on legislative leaders, tougher financial disclosures for politicians, and new limits on insider lobbyists. DeLuca even closed the "revolving door" that allowed politicians to retire early and sell their insider access as lobbyists.

DeLuca is fighting for property tax relief for seniors. He voted to cut seniors' property taxes by expanding the value of key exemptions and increasing eligibility for senior property tax relief.

DeLuca is standing up for seniors who have been isolated from loved ones during the COVID-19 pandemic. He voted to require nursing homes to help facilitate at least one phone or video call a day between a resident and their family during these difficult times.

DeLuca is standing up against hateful disruptions at military funerals. He is supporting a measure that would ensure families of the fallen can honor their loved ones in peace by preventing extremist groups from protesting near funerals for former service members.
